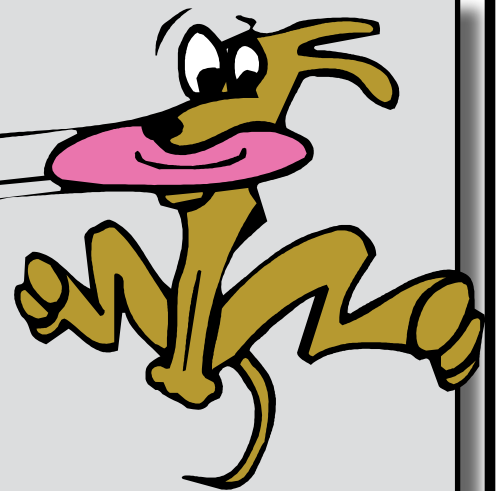

## Happenings | by Chris Comins

In May and June the shelter took in 71 dogs of which 37 came from owners, 13 came in as strays, 11 (one of which was pregnant) came from the Pueblo Community Animal Shelter (PAS). The pregnant Rottweiler mix had 10 puppies but unfortunately 6 only survived a few days despite all efforts. The shelter did have 64 dogs get rehomed, 2 returned to owners and 5 transferred to other no-kill agencies. The transfers were arranged by, who else?, Tonya Barker. Norman and Sammy got into the Prison Canine Program, Eddie and Song went to Vail and found homes. Shadow, with us several years because of a urinary problem, found a great home on a ranch near Vail. Tonya also found Little Bear, another long time resident, a loving, wonderful home. The success stories for rehoming the animals that come to us just keeps growing! Thanks to all our supporters without whom we could not do what we do.

Speaking of supporters, those individuals, groups and businesses that hold special fundraisers for PAWS for Life for the current operations or for the building of the new shelter are very much appreciated. Each of those fundraisers help not only financially but also builds awareness of PAWS for Life mission and need for a new facility. Recently, the **Pirate's Cove** held a special event for us. Kevin & Adrienne Smith (**Hazoma Wishing Well**) of Colorado Springs give us donations from the Coin Race Game that is at the Pueblo Mall. Also **Production Plan It, Inc** also in Colorado Springs sent us a share of the proceeds from the Pup Cup.

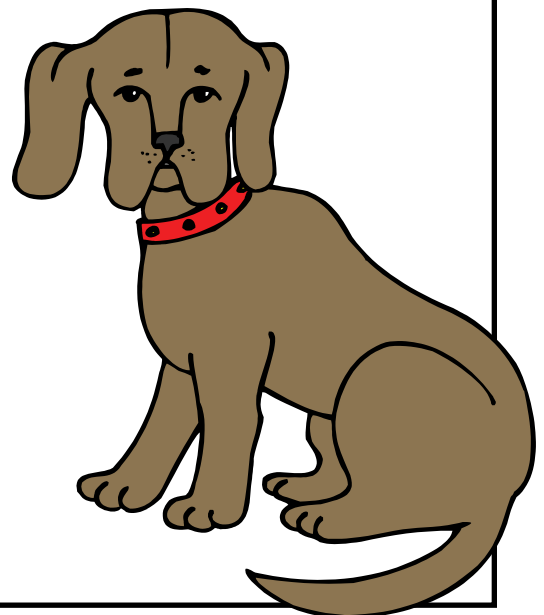

They delivered many of them to us and **Sandy Bradley** spearheaded getting many of them sold for PAWS (almost \$2,000 worth at great prices) and the rest given to other organizations.

The **23rd Feet n Fur** to benefit 4-H **Mighty Dogs Club**, PAWS for Life, **Pet Project** and **Pueblo Animal Services** will be held in conjunction with **Roselawn's 2nd Pet Fest**. Not only did the **City Parks Department** approve the event for Sept. 11, BUT they also want to start a *Dog Days of Summer Swim Day*. The City Park pool would be open on Sept. 11 for people to bring their dogs to swim! There would be an entrance fee to the pool. Some Pet Fest contests might also be held at the pool for dogs!! 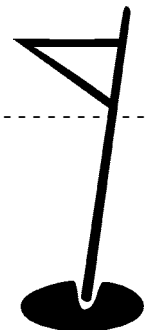

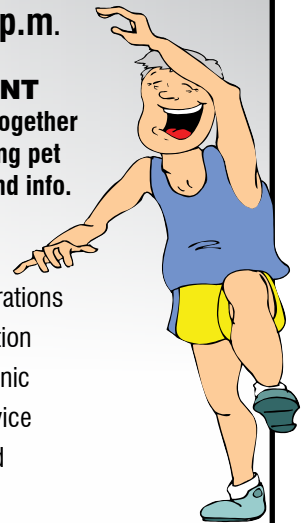
