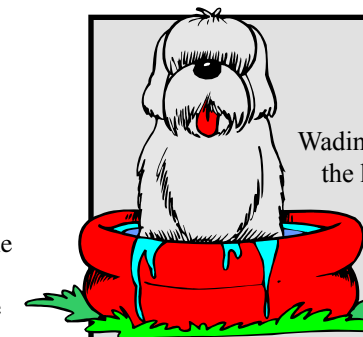


Senior adoption day

PLANT SALE: This sale is one of our top fundraisers thanks to Kay and Gary Crites of Crites' Greenhouse, Paula & Pat Martin of Martin's Greenhouse and Board member Carolyn Christopher (Patio Pots, Etc.) who makes and donates all the ceramic pots and other items. Another good success and the weather pretty much cooperated! At least it was not blazing hot! Thanks to all our supporters who wait for this sale and Sherri Pullara of Pepper's Plus who takes the items that were not sold. The sale day went smoothly with help from Board members Sandra Young, Bev Kachel, Peggy Greathouse, Sandi Blatnik, Cheryl Hindsley, Chris Comins, Carolyn Christopher, Barb Caudle, Carole McKinney, Marilyn Thompson, Carol Warner and volunteers Sandy Bradley, Lora Lindgren, and Joyce Giadone.

INS & OUTS: The PAWS for Life Shelter is very pleased to say that adoptions have continued to be up through March and

April with 58 dogs being rehomed and one going back to its owner. The shelter took in 61 dogs including 38 owner surrenders, 2 strays and 21 transfers in from Pueblo Animal Services. To the end of April, 103 dogs have come in and 98 have gone out. If that trend continues about 300 dogs will have come through the shelter in 2009 - about a 39% increase. An average of 10 dogs a month are being transferred in from the City/County Shelter.

INSPECTION: The State Vet's office has done a routine inspection of the shelter and there are only some minor infractions - mostly in record keeping that need to be addressed.

GRANTING WISHES: Thanks to those supporters who bring in items from the wish list. Your donations really help. Two printers (with extra ink!) have been donated. One will be used in the motorhome "office" when that is ready and the other will be used to copy needed forms and other things.

Volunteer Age Policy

At the May Board of Directors' meeting, the Board authorized the following policy for volunteers: All volunteers must fill out and sign a volunteer application and liability agreement. Those who are 16 or 17 must have a parent or guardian also sign. Those who are under 16 years of

age must have a parent/guardian signature AND have a volunteer over 18 accompany them. We know that there are many younger responsible teens and children who would like to volunteer but the shelter does not have enough staff to be able to supervise volunteers under 16 years old.

The Pantry Restaurant ~ A Long Time Supporter

Not only has the Pantry Restaurant on Abriendo across from the main library been a local landmark for dining in Pueblo but they have also been a great supporter of Animal Welfare. They were one of the first to have an AWPS cash collection box in their business. For at least 15 years, clients have put their change in a cash box sitting right by the cash register.

Many months the box fills up. Over the years, the collection has been a really big help to the shelter residents. By mistake the Pantry's name has been missing from the cash box list in the last few newsletters. AWPS apologizes and wants the owners, staff, and clientele of the Pantry to know how much their support has been and is appreciated and needed.

Local Students Help AWPS

South Mesa Elementary School's Kindness and Caring - "KC Club" under the direction of Mrs. Jacie Fisher and Jennifer Daurio chose Animal Welfare for their service project. This year the students gathered and made colorful goodie bags filled with treats and hand written notes to be given to new owners when they adopt a dog. They also collected Cents for the Pets and donated the

proceeds. We look forward to establishing an ongoing educational program with the school. Thanks kids for CARING!

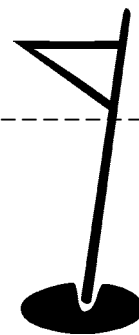
