Re: Changes in PAWS Operations Due to the Increased Risk of COVID-19

Due to the increase of positive COVID-19 cases and the county's movement to Orange-High Risk Safer at Home PAWS for Life will be modifying our operations and public interaction November 15th – November 30th.

We will be open by appointment only for tours, meet and greets, and adoptions. Community Food bank participants do not need an appointment (see instructions below). We will not allow walk-in tours during this time. If you are interested in adopting a new best friend, please check our website at www.pawspueblo.org often, as this is the most reliable way to see animals available for adoption. You can contact us to schedule your appointment at (719) 543-6464 or email contactus@pawspueblo.org. All visitors must sign-in on the visitor log.

Shelter Tours: Tours will be limited to two (2) persons at a time escorted by a PAWS employee. Everyone must wear masks at all times while in the shelter.

Meet & Greets: Outside meets will be open to all household members when meeting a dog. Inside or Cat Meet and Greets will be limited to (2) persons at a time to ensure social distancing. Masks are required at all times inside the shelter.

Adoptions: Do to limited office space, all adoption paperwork will need to be filled out in your vehicle, outside, or by only (1) adopter in the office. Masks are required at all times while in the shelter. Shelter staff will still allow adopters to spend quality one on one time with their potential new pet and will be available to answer any questions you may have.

Community Food Program: You must call 719-543-6464 from outside the building, if possible remain in your vehicle. PAWS staff will bring the food out to you for a curbside pick-up.

We appreciate your help during this unusual time, and your patience in following our new visitor protocols. Your compliance will allow us to remain open safely and do our very best to protect our family and yours.
