The terms and conditions listed below are required of all volunteers participating in any activity on shelter grounds or other location involving PAWS for Life, board members, staff, animals or other volunteers:

- Directions will be issued and authorized only by a staff or board member.
- Behavior with the staff, the public, other volunteers and the board members will be respectful at all times. Rudeness will not be tolerated. Any complaints will be reviewed.
- Tennis or walking shoes are required unless otherwise approved for the activity. Earbuds are not allowed.
- Volunteers are subject to a background investigation. If you have a felony on your record, you will not be allowed to volunteer.
- We are a drug-free entity with a zero tolerance for drugs and alcohol. This applies to all PAWS activities on or off campus.
- PAWS is not responsible for any illness or injury caused by any animals that you come in contact with during involvement in volunteer activities. I hereby agree to hold harmless and release from liability PAWS, its Board of Directors, employees and other volunteers should you become sick or injured as a result of any volunteer work.
- If I am an adoption worker at PetSmart or Petco, or any off-site location, I understand that none of these organizations are responsible for any illness or injury caused by any animals that I come in contact with during my volunteer work. I hereby agree to hold harmless and release from any liability PetSmart, Petco, or any other entity should I become sick or injured as a result of my volunteer work.
- All minors younger than 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

- Grooming

Shelter Maintenance

- Clean cages
- General cleaning
- Painting
- Electrical(must be licensed)
- Plumbing(must be licensed)
- HVAC(must be licensed)
- Maintain and/or repair fences and cages

Grounds Maintenance

- Landscaping
- Maintain landscaping equipment
- Snow removal
- Cleaning sidewalks
- Maintain parking area

Vehicle Maintenance

- Car washes (interior/exterior)
- Vehicle maintenance/repair
- Transport vehicles for maintenance/repair
- Must Have a valid driver's license

Transport Animals/Supplies

- Transport animals to & from vet appointments
- Transport animals to & from PAWS events
- Ensure adequate water/food for animals during transport/events
- Transport donated supplies
- Must have valid driver's license

Animal Fostering

- Provide animal care according to PAWS requirements

Fundraising

- Provide assistance prior to or at any money making event

Education/Outreach

- Develop/maintain materials for education & outreach opportunities
- Assist with talks to interested parties
- Assist at booths for PAWS at civic events

Clerical

- Answer phones & make calls
- Data entry
- Copy forms as needed
- Assist shelter greeters as needed
- Assist in contacting other volunteers
- Maintain presence in front office
- Maintain volunteer sign in/sign out sheet
- Assist with thank you notes/birthday greetings to volunteers

Shelter Greeter

- Make first contact with guests to find out their needs
- Assist guests with necessary paperwork
- Direct guests to appropriate shelter staff
- May assist in other ways when guests are taken care of

Adoptathon Worker

- Work at Retail Adoptathons
